## NEW RULES FOR ENTERING

The Staff, Management and Charity Volunteers are glad to have you back. In order to keep everyone safe we will be doing things a bit different for a while until we beat COVID-19. You will see below we have some new rules and some game changes. Please note this will be temporary.

Thank you and we are glad to see you back.

- 1) All patrons temperature will be checked at the entrance. If it is above 38 Degrees Celcius than you will not be admitted into our facility.
- 2) All patrons must wear a mask while in the facility (AODA exemptions apply). If you do not have one when arriving Jackpot City has a "Covid-19 Kit" available for \$3.00 – the kit includes a reusable cotton mask and 2 antiseptic wipes (retail Value of \$10.00).
- 3) You must complete the customer check in form in order for the local health unit to contact you if needed.
- 4) Back packs are not permitted on the premises.
- 5) When we are not at capacity you are welcome to watch others play and mingle in the facility. Once at capacity you must be playing a machine or exit the facility as this affects our permitted occupancy.
- 6) You must maintain your social distancing of 6 feet at all times.
- 7) Practice safety by washing your hands and using the sanitizing stations whenever possible.
- 8) Only machines powered on will be marked and available for use. You must practice social distancing and stay a min. of 6 feet away from other patrons. Any player station or device that is turned off and has the chair removed is not permitted for use.
- 9) Seating for bingo will be designated. There will be specified seats where you will be able to sit. No sitting next to anyone unless you are from the same household and you will be required to show proof. Moving of chairs will not be permitted.
- 10) Snack Bar will have a limited menu and all self serve will not be permitted (refills have been discontinued).
- 11) No outside food or beverage permitted.
- 12) You must follow the arrows and adhere to the directions on the floor signs.
- 13) We have designated 1 entrance and 1 exit. These are the only doors that will be used. The other doors are only emergency exits.
- 14) You must be respectful to all staff and volunteers as the rules are mandated and we must ensure they are maintained.
